Letterland:

We will now be diving deeper and spending time learning about each letter. Students will now be learning the capital letters, how to write the letter, handwriting songs, and action tricks. Keep your eyes open for the Letterland Parade letter, coming home soon!

ELA:

This week and next week we will review syllables, rhyming words and reading consonant-vowel-consonant words. We will also be finding the main idea and key details in nonfiction texts. We will go back and review key details in a fictional text.

Math:

We will be comparing five frames and ten frames. Students will also look at the "plus one" pattern. (2 is 1+1, 3 is 2+1, etc.) We will then go back and work on more, less, and equal using a variety of strategies.

Social Studies/Science:

We will continue to work on our new social studies unit, Wants and Needs. The students will continue to sort wants and needs as well as understand healthy wants and needs.

Writing:

In writing we are thinking of a true moment with the class and then retelling the story using pictures and sounding out word. Please encourage your child to draw a picture and TRY to sound out the words after drawing the picture.
