Letterland:

We have completed our Fast Track Section of Letterland. We will now be diving deeper and spending time learning about each letter. Students will now be learning the capital letters, how to write the letter, handwriting songs, and action tricks.

ELA:

This week we will begin the Guided Reading portion of Daily 5. Students will meet with the teacher and work on reading books at their reading level. This week and next week we will begin learning about rhyming words through nursery rhymes. We will also be using our "Eagle Eyes" to read the words by matching them to the picture.



Math:

We will be working with quantities up to the number ten and showing them in different arrangements. We will also review a few math concepts such as knowing how many without counting when one more object is added on. For example, if I counted five squares and put one more square with the group, now I have six.

Social Studies/Science:

We will continue science by talking about our five senses and completing experiments that use our five senses such as a popcorn experiment.

Writing:

In writing we are thinking of a true moment with the class and then retelling the story using pictures and sounding out word. Please encourage your child to draw a picture and TRY to sound out the words after drawing the picture.
